



RV RESORT

It's time to eat again so we're off to Der Dutchman in Walnut Creek. This restaurant has a terrific view of the valley out the picture windows of the dining room. Just down the


street from the restaurant is Coblentz Chocolate Company, and they have over 114 hand-made candies in the store.
